



Free Bikes 4 Kidz was founded by a group of community-minded cyclists in Minneapolis in 2008. That first year's giveaway of 300 bikes was just the beginning. Since then, FB4K has given away more refurbished bikes annually than any other organization – over 60,000 bikes to date. In 2015, Free Bikes 4 Kidz Utah became the first affiliate outside Minnesota. FB4K organizations can now be found in eight states – and counting!

Free Bikes 4 Kidz (FB4K) is a nonprofit organization geared toward helping all kids ride into a happier, healthier childhood by providing bikes to those most in need.

FB4K Utah is a volunteer-driven organization. The volunteers organize collection, repair and distribution of used bikes to kids in need. FB4K Utah has no paid staff.

The organization has a once-a-year program to donate bikes that includes:

- bike drive to collect donations
- volunteer nights to clean and repair bicycles
- distribution days where bikes are given to community partners to distribute to their clients who are in need

The organization solicits donations of:

- used bicycles
- warehouse space as a base of operations for collection, repair and distribution
- monetary donations for bike parts, helmets, printing and other supplies

The 2019 based program is based in South Salt Lake City, at 2250 S Main Street, in warehouse space donated by Dakota Pacific. 2019 program sponsors include:

Free Bikes 4 Kidz receives donated bikes from individuals, the Salt Lake Bicycle Collective, bicycle shops, and other sources. In 2019, the South Salt Lake Police Department has donated unclaimed bikes from police evidence.
