

Central Wasatch Commission Short-Term Projects Committee

During its 2019 annual Board Retreat, the Central Wasatch Commission Board proposed the creation of three committees to the Commission, one of which was a Short-Term Projects Committee. The Commission assigned Millcreek, Park City, and Salt Lake County (either Mayor Wilson or Councilman Bradley) as the foundational members of the committee, however, any Commissioner may join the committee if they wish. The Commission will complete a poll to identify priority projects for the Short-Term Projects Committee, and the Committee will meet after the December 2nd Board meeting for its first meeting during which a meeting schedule will be determined. The Short-Term Projects Committee meetings will be noticed in compliance with the Open and Public Meetings Act.

Objective

Identify short-term, achievable, and fundable projects that the Central Wasatch Commission can prioritize, and formulate a plan for implementation.

Approach

The Commission and some stakeholders will first complete a poll to identify projects that the Committee should consider for funding and planning. Consensus (defined as a two-thirds majority of the Committee Commission members) will be considered for purposes of arriving at approaches to issues identified.

Process

1. At its first meeting (following the December 2nd Board meeting), the Committee will review the poll responses, define what “short-term” means, identify priority projects, begin considering funding, timelines, and plans for each priority project, as well as set a committee meeting schedule.
2. Subsequent meetings for each priority project to flesh out funding, timelines, and plans for each priority project.
3. The Committee will update the Commission at each monthly meeting and receive feedback.
4. Success will be defined by the Committee, and will likely include a plan for funding the project, and a clear plan for implementation of the project.
