

Notice of Intent to Amend the Downtown Master Plan

Salt Lake City's Downtown Master Plan will provide a new direction for the Downtown and help fulfill the goals emerging from Plan Salt Lake. Coordination with parallel efforts such as the Downtown Streetcar, Wasatch Choice for 2040, and the Bike/Pedestrian Master Plan will occur. The Downtown Master Plan will support and balance land use, transportation, housing, development, social, and sustainability goals.


To reach these goals, the Downtown Master Plan will have the following outcomes:

- Where we want to go: a clear vision and supporting principles
- How we will get there: a set of goals, objectives and policies that meet the needs of the current and future Downtown community
- Details of how we will get there: a list of priority projects intended to implement the goals
- What it will look like: an urban design framework
- How we will measure our progress: A set of performance indicators and a process for evaluating our progress.
