

UTAH OUTDOOR RECREATION GRANT SYNOPSIS

PURPOSE

The project will enhance recreational opportunities and amenities in Utah's communities

GRANT SIZE

In 2020, UORG award amounts will range from \$1,000-\$150,000.

Please note, a Regional Asset Tier will be available in 2020. Regional Asset Tier UORG funding of \$500,000 will be available for large outdoor recreation projects that will cost more than \$2,000,000. At this level, applicants must present to the Outdoor Recreation Advisory Committee in-person. Scores will be based not only on application questions, but also a five-minute in-person presentation, and each applicant's response to questions from the committee. Up to two Regional Asset Tier awards will be given in 2020.

GRANT PERIOD OPEN

The 2020 UORG cycle will be open from January 15 to March 20, 2020. Make sure to sign-up for Utah Outdoors at the bottom of the page to receive email alerts and updates about the grant and our office.

GENERAL ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Local or tribal governments or non-profits may apply. The built recreational infrastructure must provide an economic opportunity for the local area with the ability to increase visitation, boost local businesses and/or attract and retain residents.

GRANT APPLICATION DEADLINE

Friday, March 20, 2020 by 5 p.m. Mountain Time.

MATCH COMPONENT

Given as a 50/50 match. Up to 25 percent of the total match may be an in-kind match. Please note, the match component differs for a Regional Asset Tier grant; information regarding the Regional Asset Tier can be found on page 2 of the 2020 Program Guide.

CONTRACT/REPORTING REQUIREMENTS

Project must be complete within 24 months of date the contract is signed. Funding is given after the applicant's spend. Up to 75 percent of the matched monies may be given before completion of project. Grant recipients will need to provide a project progress report twice a year until completion. Final funding contingent upon inspection of the completed project.
