



NOTICE OF ELECTION AND FILING PERIOD


NOTICE is hereby given that the Town of Stockton will hold a municipal election to elect one (1) Mayor, two (2) Town Council positions, all four year terms and one (1) Town Council position for a two year term. Given a sufficient number of candidates, a primary election will be held on August 13, 2013, with the municipal general election being held on November 5, 2013.

Qualifications for a candidate are: (1) Be a United States citizen at the time of filing; (2) Be a registered voter of the municipality; (3) Be a resident of the municipality or a resident of the recent annexed area for a period of 12 consecutive months immediately preceding the date of the election.

Qualified candidates may file a Declaration of Candidacy form. The filing is to be done in person with the City Recorder at Stockton Town Hall, 18 No. Johnson St., Stockton, Utah. The filing period is from June 3, 2013 to June 17, 2013, during regular office hours 9:00 a.m. through 4:00 p.m. and not later than 5:00 p.m. on the last day of filing. All candidates for election are subject to financial disclosure requirements.
