



COVID-19 Shutdown

During the shutdown for COVID-19 all classes/sessions that have been canceled/postponed, participants have been contacted with updates on the program and refunded for canceled classes.

As programmers we have been trying to keep in touch with the public as much as possible with updates and answering any questions through email and phone calls.

At the beginning of April we put all signups on hold. The purpose of this was that we already had people signed up with two different dates (as we had set new dates for the initial shutdown in March) for activities and we believe that it was best to put signups on hold until we have concrete dates. Another factor with this was that if we did have to cancel completely it would save us money on the credit card transaction fees.

We are always trying to brainstorm new ideas to adapt existing programs for new dates/ shorter seasons. Daily changes with the status of COVID-19 have us also thinking of new programs we can offer in a safer environment moving forward.
