

# NOTICE OF HEARING

## TO OWNERS OF PROPERTY WITHIN THE GREENDALE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT PROJECT AREA

On November 8, 2012, the Daggett County Redevelopment Agency, Utah (the "Agency"), by resolution, (a) designated the Greendale Community Development Project Area (the "Project Area") which is defined by the legal description and map attached to the proposed Draft Project Area Plan, and (b) authorized the preparation of a Draft Project Area Plan for the Project Area.

The Draft Plan for the Project Area has been prepared and the Agency now gives notice that **the Agency will hold a public hearing on the Draft Plan and all concerned citizens are invited to attend the hearing scheduled for July 2, 2013, at 10:00 a.m. or as soon after that time as possible, at the Daggett County offices located at 95 North 1<sup>st</sup> West, Manila, Utah.** At the public hearing, the Agency will hear public comment on and objections, if any, to the Draft Plan, including whether the Draft Plan should be revised, approved, or rejected. The Agency will also receive all written objections to the Draft Plan. All interested persons, including the recipient of this notice, are invited to submit to the Agency comments on the Draft Plan before the date of the hearing.

Any person objecting to the Draft Plan or contesting the regularity of any of the proceedings to adopt it may appear before the Agency Board at the hearing to show cause why the Draft Plan should not be adopted.
