5:30 PM REGULAR SESSION – VIA ZOOM

The meeting was recorded and conducted virtually on Zoom due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

In attendance: Kena Mathews, Steven Downs, Jeff Lambson, Christine Alleman, Stacy Goulding, and Spencer Rands.

: 01 - Steven Downs welcomed everyone.

: 03 - Minutes from the April 16, 2020 CARE Commission Meeting were unanimously approved. Spencer Rands made the motion, Christine Alleman seconded.

: 25 – Mr. Downs reviewed the amount of funding available for the mini and mid-major CARE requests with the recent sales and CARE tax decreases due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The amount available for mini and mid-major CARE grant requests will be \$64,500. This is a decrease of 7.6 percent from last year's allocations.

3:40 - The CARE Commission discussed the mini and mid-major applications and determined recommended allocation amounts. Steven also addressed their previous questions about Freedom Vehicles, events tied to the Freedom Festival, and both Shakespeare organizations. He also gave the Commission information on the allocation amount available for major CARE applicants.
