RECOMMENDATION:

The City Attorney recommends that the City Council adopt a Resolution of Eagle Mountain City, Utah, repealing the Franchise Fee / Utility Tax on the Eagle Mountain Water Utility.

BACKGROUND:

In 2003, the City enacted a 3% utility tax (also referred to as a franchise fee) on certain utilities in the City, which percentage was increased to 6% in fiscal year 2006. The 6% utility tax is consistent with the amount charged by most municipalities in Utah. Based on the recommendation of the City Council, the resolution would repeal the 6% utility tax on the City's water utility.
