The appointed Council Member will serve through the vacated term of Council Member Daniel Cluff ending December 31, 2021.

Eligibility and Residency Requirements:

- 1) Candidates must be a United States citizen at time of filing for candidacy.
- 2) Candidates must be at least 18 years of age at the time of the appointment.
- 3) Candidates must be a legal resident of the municipality for 12 consecutive months immediately preceding the date of appointment.
- 4) Candidate must be a registered voter of the municipality.

Pursuant to Utah Constitution Article IV, Section 6, any mentally incompetent person, any person convicted of a felony, or any person convicted of treason or a crime against the elective franchise may not hold office in this state until the right to vote or hold elective office is restored as provided by statute.

Letter of Intent: Along with your request please submit your answer to the following questions to verify eligibility requirements:

- 1. Are you a United States citizen at this time?
- 2. Are you at least 18 years of age as of August 26, 2020?
- 3. Have you been a Washington City resident for the previous 12 consecutive months?
- 4. Are you a Washington City registered voter?

Additional questions;

- 5. Why do you desire to serve on the City Council?
- 6. How long have you lived in Washington City?
- 7. What do you have to bring or offer as a City Council Member?
- 8. Do you intend to file for "Candidacy for Office" in the 2021 election?
