**STATE MONEY MANAGEMENT COUNCIL-MINUTES**  
**THURSDAY MAY 23, 2013**

The regular meeting of the State Money Management Council was held in the Offices of the State Treasurer, 350 North State Street, Suite 180 at 3:00 p.m., Thursday, May 23, 2013. In attendance were:

**Minutes of April Meeting**

The minutes of the April 18, 2013 meeting were approved unanimously with changes as noted.

**Monthly Reports**

**Securities Division:**

Ms. Black distributed the lists for Certified Dealers noting that there was one new agent added with George K Baum. She then passed out the lists for the Certified Investment Advisers noting that there is one new firm, PFM Asset Management with two agents. It was noted that Mr. Blackwood was in attendance with that firm. Council discussed the lists briefly.

**Financial Institutions' Report:**

Mr. Jones presented the April monthly reports for Mr. Bay. He reviewed the report noting for the Council that Gunnison Valley Bank was over their allotment as of the end of April. He informed the Council that Mr. Bay had called Gunnison Valley Bank and that they informed him that they were now under the maximum allotment. The funds were from the hospital district in Gunnison. Council discussed the monthly report with Mr. Jones briefly.

**State Treasurers Report:**

Ms. Brandt noted for the Council that the balance in the PTIF as of April month end was \$10.1 billion and the rate paid was .52% and that the rate is continuing to decline. She informed the Council that they anticipate that the rate will stabilize in the low to mid .40bp. Ms. Brandt noted

that the change extending the maturity date on corporates has allowed more access to product. Council discussed the report briefly.

**Late Deposit and Investment Report Update:**

Ms. Pedroza informed the Council that there are 37 reports that have not been filed for the December 2012 reporting period.

**Review of Enforcement Actions:**

Mr. Damschen informed the Council that there were no new enforcement actions since the last meeting.

**Acceptance of Reports:**

It was motioned and seconded, and all of the above reports were accepted unanimously.

**Discussion on Rules and Procedures for Writing New Rules Required by a Change in Statute.**

Ms. Pedroza provided the Council with information from the Administrative Rules website which describes the general setup and format of rules. Council also discussed the time frames and requirements for comment periods, filing and effective dates. Council then discussed how a rule is written. It was noted that they can create a task force, direct staff to prepare a draft and review that in the meeting, or direct specific members to write the draft all for review in future meetings. Council discussed this briefly and Mr. DeFries and Mr. Bond agreed to work on the reciprocal deposits rule with Mr. Damschen.

**Other Business**

E-mail from State Auditor's Office regarding the Act and Reports:

Mr. McRae reviewed briefly for the other members the report that public entities are required to file with the Council. He noted that the State Auditor has a handbook with requirements for the outside auditors that audit public entities, and one of the steps is to review securities and deposits for compliance to the Act. The Auditors want to change the procedure. Mr. Ellis felt that the auditors should test more not less and Council discussed this with Mr. Ellis, Ms. Noda and Ms. Ross at length. After this discussion the Council made a motion and approved it asking that the Auditor's office be contacted and request that the procedures currently in place be left and other steps be taken to ensure compliance.

Training-Role of the Council:

Ms. Pedroza went over the role of the Council noting what field of experience is represented on the Council, how long the members are appointed for and what a quorum consists of. Under Section 51-7-18, she reviewed what the Council's duties are noting that they have to review the Council rules adopted under the Act, distribute those rules and lists of certified dealers, qualified depositories and investment advisers to public treasurers. She noted that Council may recommend changes to the Act and may make rules. Ms. Pedroza informed the Council that they cannot make rules requiring collateral unless public funds are in excess of a qualified depository's maximum allotment. Council discussed this briefly and asked about board member

liability. Ms. Noda noted that if the Council acts under their scope of authority then there is no liability.

**Schedule Next Meeting**

The Council then scheduled the next meeting for June 20, 2013 at 3:00 p.m. in the offices of the State Treasurer, and then noted that there would not be a meeting in July and tentatively scheduled the August meeting for the 15th of that month. With no other business before the Council, they adjourned at 4:32 p.m.


