

**ORDER ON PUBLIC MEETINGS OF THE  
SOUTH DAVIS RECREATION DISTRICT**

I, Tamilyn Fillmore, as the Chair of the Board of Trustees ("Board") for the South Davis Recreation District ("District"), do hereby find and declare as follows:

1. Due to the Emergency conditions which currently exist in the State of Utah, and specifically in Davis County as a result of the COVID-19 Pandemic and the recent surge in COVID-19 infections across the state and in Davis County, the holding of public meetings with an anchor location as defined in the *Utah Open and Public Meetings Act*, presents a substantial risk to the health and safety of those who may be present at the anchor location; and
2. The risk to those who may be present at an anchor location can be substantially mitigated by holding public meetings of the Board pursuant to electronic means that allow for public participation via virtual means; and
3. The District has the means and ability to allow virtual participation in the public meetings in accordance with the *Utah Open and Public Meetings Act*;


**NOW THEREFORE, BASED UPON THE FOREGOING,**

For thirty days from the date of this Order, meetings of the South Davis Recreation District Board of Trustees shall be conducted by electronic means without an anchor location.
