

**MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF CANVASERS FOR THE NOVEMBER 3, 2020
GENERAL ELECTION,
HELD ON NOVEMBER 16, 2020 BEGINNING AT 1:30 P.M.
IN THE COMMISSION CHAMBERS IN DUCHESNE, UTAH**

PRESENT: Commissioner Chairman Greg Todd; Commissioner Irene Hansen; Commissioner Greg Miles;
Clerk-Auditor JoAnn Evans; Records Specialist Cristina Neilson.

The Board of Canvassers convened at the designated place and time.

Duchesne County no longer has polling locations throughout the county. It is an ALL-BY-MAIL/ABSENTEE County. All poll workers were required to wear protective gear when handling ballots. All ballots were counted by November 13, 2020 in preparation of the canvass on Monday, November 16, 2020.

There were 9918 active voters in Duchesne County at the time the numbers were added into the counting system. There were 8531 at the beginning of the by-mail process. Throughout the Mail/Absentee process there were ballots issued to voters for Duchesne County; 8589 were returned and counted. There are 62 provisional ballots counted; 20 after the election uploaded for the canvas; 126 early voting ballots counted; 165 of the ballots were returned for various reasons; 6 ballots that came in after the November 2, 2020 deadline; 23 ballots that cannot be counted because they have no signature and file, and who received a phone call or a cure letter to let the voter know this needed to be corrected; 44 ballots that cannot be counted because their signature did not match, and who received a phone call or a cure letter to let the voter know this needed to be corrected. Giving us an 86.60% turnout.

Commission Chairman Greg Todd declared the election official and the results final.
