Ether Hollow Fire notification when out on Everbridge; went out on 2 channels; thought it was 2 separate fire entries; wind speed increased to 55 mph winds caused fire to burn 1000 acres in 10 minutes. Hobble Creek Canyon road was clogging up the road and made it hard for fire trucks and emergency personnel (Grindstone, Oakley, Mapleton) Communicate to responders that you’re out of the house by putting trash can in the middle of the driveway; John Peterson asked where the evacuees go; Chief Clinton replied that we don’t know; it’s not our concern (as fire fighters), Chief Clinton does advise everyone to have a plan in place. We know that some evacuees went to the Mapleton city center and a couple of churches opened up; Springville city rodeo grounds opened up for livestock.

High probability of debris slides; JoAnna Larsen says our area has a high potential of landslide on both Mapleton and Springville sides;

Red Cross puts people in hotels and provides snacks for displaced persons; Red Cross never self deploys so Austin Clark has to track down where the evacuation point is (one site is best) Generally Red Cross gets called in to police dispatch; general methods is emergency manager; make sure you have a pet crate for transport and to stay overnight.

Red Cross needs to be called out by SOMEONE; Red Cross has 100 cots located in a trailer in Springville
