ADMINISTRATIVE BUSINESS:

Call Meeting to Order

Dr. Bowen called the meeting to order at 9:01 a.m.

Read and Approve September 4, 2020 Minutes (0:05)

Ms. Miley made a motion approving the minutes as amended.

Ms. Harris seconded the motion.

The Board motion passed unanimously.

APPOINTMENTS:

TYPODENT STANDARDS

This item was discussed with the exam updates discussion.

EXAM UPDATES (0:07)

Dr. Bowen welcomed and introduced Dr. Licari to the meeting.

Dr. Licari reviewed changes and options for the Objective Structure Clinical Exam (OSCE) exam.

Dr. Poulson asked if the Board could evaluate the OSCE exam.

Dr. Licari stated there may be a presentation provided to Boards for review and approval of the exam. Dr. Licari stated several components of the exam involve new technology which is why it has not been utilized until now.

Ms. Young asked if the OSCE would be a stand-alone test or if it would be combined with a clinical exam.

Dr. Licari stated the development of the test allows for administration as a stand-alone exam; however, there is an option for the OSCE to be taken in combination with other exams as established by each state board.

Dr. Talbot asked if states utilizing the OSCE at this time are requiring a clinical portion or if the exam is being approved as a stand-alone exam.

Dr. Licari stated it is his understanding that the OSCE is currently a stand-alone requirement in response to the pandemic.

CDCA REPORT (0:21)

Dr. Bowen welcomed Ms. Overfelt and Mr. Shampaine from CDCA.

Dr. Shampaine reviewed a presentation concerning the CDCA CompoDont manikin based exam.

Ms. Harris asked how many states have accepted the manikin exam.

Dr. Shampaine stated there is a map available on the website that breaks down requirements and accepted exams from each state.

Ms. Overfelt reviewed the OSCE exam for dental hygiene students.

WREB REPORT (:58)

Dr. Bowen welcomed Dr. Christensen from WREB.

Dr. Christensen reviewed a presentation concerning the WREB exams that will be available in 2021.

Ms. Young asked how many versions of the mandible are available for the hygiene exam.

Dr. Christensen stated the candidate will use one arch for the assessment detection and a different arch for the calculus removal.

Dr. Poulson asked if the criteria used to grade the operative will be the same as when the exam is patient based.

Dr. Christensen stated the criteria is essentially the same with some minor changes.

Dr. Gatrell stated the UDA's stance is that hand-skill testing is important and they are in support of moving away from live patient tests. Dr. Gatrell stated the UDA has surveyed several practicing Utah dentists and the majority are in support of moving away from live patient tests.

DAN POULSON (Audio 2 0:17)

Dr. Poulson reviewed his experience reviewing the WREB manikin teeth. Dr. Poulson stated the importance that all manikin teeth be equal in difficulty. Dr. Poulson reviewed different manikin teeth and the differences between them.

Dr. Bowen asked if Dr. Poulson would have any hesitation in approving the CDCA manikin tooth.

Dr. Poulson stated he has no issues accepting the CDCA exam tooth.

Dr. Bowen stated his review of the WREB tooth. Dr. Bowen stated he has not had the opportunity to review the CDCA tooth.

Dr. Christensen stated the manufacturing process may result in some production flaws; however, it is not a regular occurrence.

Dr. Poulson asked what the most common reasons for not passing the test.

Dr. Christensen stated the beta tests are on-going and a report has not been completed at this time.

Dr. Bowen requested the results prior to the December meeting if they are available.

KATHY HARRIS (1:41 & Audio 2)

Ms. Harris reviewed her experience of participating in the CDCA dental hygiene exam. Ms. Harris stated support of the available Dental Hygiene manikin exam.

Dr. Poulson asked if there is a calibration component and what was the overall pass rate.
