

NOTICE OF PROPOSED TAX INCREASE Daggett County

The Daggett County is proposing to increase its property tax revenue.

- The Daggett County tax on a \$150,000 residence would increase from \$326.04 to \$386.35, which is \$60.31 per year.
- The Daggett County tax on a \$150,000 business would increase from \$592.80 to \$702.45 which is \$109.65 per year.
- If the proposed budget is approved, Daggett County would increase its property tax budgeted revenue by 17.54% above last year's property tax budgeted revenue excluding new growth.

Daggett County property tax revenue from new growth and other sources will increase from \$1,017,687 to \$1,216,781.

All concerned citizens are invited to a public hearing on the tax increase.
