

NOTICE OF PROPOSED TAX INCREASE
Woodland Hills City

The Woodland Hills City is proposing to increase its property tax revenue.

- The Woodland Hills City tax on a \$219,400 residence would increase from \$650.89 to \$756.84, which is \$105.95 per year.
- The Woodland Hills City tax on a \$219,400 business would increase from \$1,183.44 to \$1,376.08 which is \$192.64 per year.
- If the proposed budget is approved, Woodland Hills City would increase its property tax budgeted revenue by 13.23% above last year's property tax budgeted revenue excluding new growth.

Woodland Hills City property tax revenue from new growth and other sources will increase from \$413,503 to \$469,368.

All concerned citizens are invited to a public hearing on the tax increase.
