



Re: Public Meeting with No Anchor Determination

December 12, 2020

I, Danny Goode am the Chair of the Wasatch County Council. Pursuant to Utah Code 52-4-207, I hereby make a written determination that conducting public meetings with an anchor location presents a substantial risk to the health and safety of those who may be present at the anchor location.

This determination is based on:

- The ongoing COVID-19 pandemic;
- The Nation Emergency Concerning the Novel Coronavirus Disease Outbreak, declared by President Trump March 13, 2020;
- The State of Emergency declared by Governor Herbert;
- COVID-19 has been characterized by the WHO as a worldwide pandemic caused by severe acute respiratory syndrome SARS-CoV-2, a virus that spreads easily from person to person and can cause serious illness and death; and
- The many COVID-19 illnesses in deaths which have occurred throughout the world, in the United States, in the State of Utah, and the County of Wasatch, which are ongoing through the date of this determination.

I direct that:

- This notice shall be included in the public notice for the meeting; and
- This notice shall be read at the beginning of any electronic public meeting which does not have an anchor location.
