NOTICE OF TECHNICAL CONFERENCES

On January 7, 2021, Dominion Energy Utah (DEU) filed with the Public Service Commission (PSC) a Notice of Intent to File Integrated Resource Plan and Request for Scheduling Order and Notice of Technical Conferences ("Notice").
