NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

In accordance with Governor Gary Herbert's Utah Executive Order 2020-1, declaring a state of emergency in response to COVID-19, Utah Executive Order 2020-5, suspending the enforcement of provisions of the Utah code §§ 52-4-2020 and 52-4-207 related to the Open Meetings Act by allowing electronic meetings without an anchor location and authorizing resolution or ordinance, Mayor Dawn Ramsey's Executive Order, and the City Planning Commission Chairperson's determination that conducting the Planning Commission meeting at an anchor location presents a substantial risk to the health and safety of those who may be present at the anchor location, the South Jordan City Planning Commission will hold an electronic meeting on Tuesday, January 26, 2021 beginning at 6:30 P.M. for the purpose of receiving public input on and reviewing each of the following:
