**RESOLUTION NO. 13-18**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TAYLORSVILLE CITY COUNCIL LEVYING AN AD VALOREM PROPERTY TAX TO FUND THE OPERATIONS OF THE CITY**

**WHEREAS**, the Taylorsville City Council ("*Council*") met in a regular meeting on August 7, 2013, where the Council conducted a properly noticed Truth in Taxation hearing wherein all interested property owners and residents of the City were invited to provide to input and information to the Council; and to consider the setting of an ad valorem property tax that exceeds the certified tax rate; and

**WHEREAS**, on May 1, 2012, the Mayor of the City of Taylorsville ("*City*") submitted to the Taylorsville City Council ("*Council*") a tentative budget, including all supporting schedules for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2014; and

**WHEREAS**, the Council has completed a review of the tentative budget presented by the Mayor and has made various amendments thereto (the resulting budget as amended shall be referred to as the "*Tentative Budget*") a copy of which is attached hereto; and

**WHEREAS**, on June 5, 2013, the Council adopted the Tentative Budget thereby authorizing the expenditures of money based on the Tentative Budget from July 1, 2013, to August 31, 2013, until after a public hearing regarding the property tax increase can be held; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:**

1. The Council having conducted the public Truth in Taxation hearing on August 7, 2013, hereby adopts Resolution 13-18, thereby budgeting an increased amount of ad valorem tax revenue to support the operations of the City of Taylorsville.
2. For the purpose of defraying the necessary and proper expenses of the City and for maintaining the government thereof, it is hereby determined that the Tax Rate of the general property tax to be levied against all real and personal property within the City made taxable by law for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2014, is hereby set to yield property tax revenues of \$\_\_\_\_\_. The certified tax rate will be set by the Salt Lake County Auditor based on the approved property tax revenue. The increase in anticipated property tax yield is has been determined to be a property tax increase and will require a Truth-in-Taxation hearing for the 2013-2014 fiscal year.
3. The administration is hereby directed to give notice hereof to the County Auditor, the Utah State Tax Commission and all other agencies designated by law.
4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.

**THIS RESOLUTION**, assigned No. 13-18, shall take effect immediately upon passage and acceptance as provided herein.
