

- Boundary School Counselor

 - Inform and advise school SST
- Student Support Team Decision
 - School SST determines
- Granite Connection Student Support Team Decision

- Steps to Ensure Granite Peaks Students Don't Fall Through the Cracks.
- Granite Peaks Enrollment 2012-2013
 - Oct 1 2012
 - Grade 11 = 51
 - Grade 10 = 4
 - May 1 2013
 - Grade 11 = 104
 - Grade 10 = 55
- Granite Peaks Enrollment 2011-2012
 - Oct 1 2011
 - Grade 11 = 82
 - Grade 10 = 8
 - May 1 2012
 - Grade 11 = 141
 - Grade 10 = 66
