AGENDA ORDER APPROVAL: Councilmember Marchant moved to approve the agenda order for both meetings; second by Councilmember Black; vote unanimous.


ADMINISTRATION AGENDA – MAYOR AND COUNCIL BUSINESS; STAFF COMMENTS:
