# **Chair's Report**

Chairman Barrus expressed his appreciation to SITLA staff for maintaining the trust assets, the School and Institutional Trust Fund Office for growing the trust, and the Land Trusts Protection & Advocacy Office for working with schools and their community councils. He also encouraged the SITLA staff to move the Northwest Quadrant project forward in a timely manner. He expressed concerns about federal executive actions on federal lands that could impact resource production on adjacent SITLA properties and called upon government leaders to ensure such actions not diminish SITLA's ability to accomplish its mandate to maximize revenues for the Trust beneficiaries.

## **Advocate Report**

Mr. Donaldson expressed thanks to those who work in all parts of the trust fund system. He gave thanks for his mentors including Margaret Bird, Dave Ure, Tom Bachtell, and Paula Plant. His current priority is to meet with and teach all state legislators about SITLA using individualized outreach materials.
