## DISCUSSION AND APPROVAL OF CM/GC FOR LEISURE POOL ROOF PROJECT

Mr. Miller reported he received two bids on the Leisure Pool Roof Project, from Gramoll
and Hogan. Mr. Miller presented the summary statement from each company and reported that
the recommendation from staff is to award the project to Hogan. Mr. Miller noted that Hogan's
evaluation score was the higher of the two companies.

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42 Mrs. Money inquired who was part of the evaluation team. Mr. Miller replied it consisted 43 of himself, Scott McDonald, Tom Lund, Tyson Beck, Nathan Leavitt, and Brent Tippets along 44 with consultation with Utah State Procurement. Mrs. Money asked if there were any guarantees 45 or reassurances with this project with awarding the contract to Hogan. Mr. Miller answered that 46 there are better air handlers available that match with the area's size and that the original tnemec 47 paint coating will be used. Mr. Millburn inquired if a cost savings is known when the tnemec 48 coating was value-engineered out of the original building. Mr. Leavitt said that he did not know a 49 figure immediately, but it could be investigated and reported on later.
