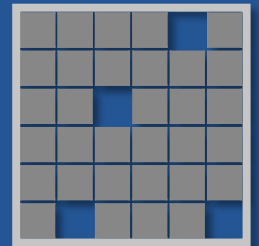

# GRAZING FEE RULE

## **R850-50-500**

- 1. An annual assessment shall be charged for each AUM authorized by the agency. This assessment shall be established by the board and shall be reviewed annually and adjusted if appropriate.**

# ASSESSMENT RATE

A new formula to establish grazing assessment rates was approved by the Board of Trustees in 2020. This formula is a percentage of the USDA National Agricultural Statistics Service (NASS) private lease rate averaged over a 3-year period. Taking a 3-year running average will help take out any drastic sways.

- Standard Assessment - 36% of the three most current years private lease rate per AUM as published by NASS:  $\$17.00 (2018) + \$18.00 (2019) + \$18.00 (2020) = \$53.00/3 = \$17.667 \times 36\% = \textbf{\$6.36/AUM}$
- Block Assessment - 63% of the three most current years private lease rate per AUM as published by NASS:  $\$17.00 (2018) + \$18.00 (2019) + \$18.00 (2020) = \$53.00/3 = \$17.667 \times 63\% = \textbf{\$11.13/AUM}$

The \$0.10/AUM Weed Fee as required by Utah Legislature will be in addition to the amounts shown above.

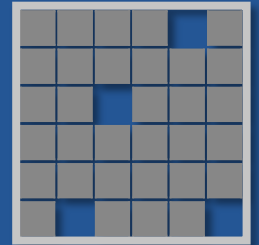
# CONCLUSION

SITLA range staff and Surface Management requests Board approval of the FY 2022 (July 2021-June 2022) grazing assessment rates set forth below:

- Standard Assessment -  $\$6.36 + \$0.10 \text{ weed feed} = \textbf{\$6.46 per AUM}$
- Block Assessment -  $\$11.13 + \$0.10 \text{ weed feed} = \textbf{\$11.23 per AUM}$

# HISTORY

- March of 2003, the Board of Trustees directed the Agency to evaluate the merits of creating a separate grazing assessment structure for selected land blocks and to explore ways of improving the overall grazing program, including stewardship practices.
- After two years of extensive analysis, a completely new structure for grazing assessments was adopted by the Board of Trustees and implemented in 2005.
- A new formula was structured to reflect market changes occurring in Utah's private lease rates and is derived through a statistical regression analysis of lease rates over the last five years. The formula applies private lease rates as reported from USDA National Agricultural Statistics Service (NASS) each year.

$$\text{UTFVI}_t = 1.01787 \times \text{UTFV}_{t-1} / \text{UTFV}_{t-2}$$

The grazing fee = base year fee (FVI + BCPI - PPI)/100. 2012 for example = \$1.23 (460 + 509 - 946)/100 = \$-0.27 (Federal). Per Executive Order, \$1.35 is the legal minimum.
