**SUBJECT:** 2013 Municipal Primary Election Canvass  
**DATE:** August 26, 2013

The prec canvass of the 2013 Municipal Primary Election was conducted Wednesday and Thursday, August 14 & 15, 2013 and Monday, August 26, 2013 by the Recorders Office. The Provisional Ballots were verified by me, using the State of Utah VISTA system (Voter Information & State Tracking Application) with assistance as needed by the Utah County Elections Office. The members of the counting team that processed the valid provisional ballots and timely absentee ballots under oath, included, Shannon Garlick, Jill Ballamis and City Recorder JoD'Ann Bates.

I have personally reviewed each of the worksheets prepared by the Poll Workers and have verified their validity. I could not find any items requiring explanation that affected the final numbers.

The City Council, acting as the Board of Canvassers, on Tuesday, August 27, 2013, will be asked to, by motion (*see page 2 for language for a possible motion*):

1. Formally certify the election results, with necessary corrections.
2. Declare the two (2) Mayor candidates and four (4) Council candidates with the highest number of votes.

## POSSIBLE MOTION

I move that the City Council:

1. Certify the election results with the following changes:
  - a. Change the Total Votes for Mayor Candidate **Mark S. Thompson from 483 to 500** on the Highland Primary Election 2013 printout to include the votes from the Provisional Ballots and timely absentees.
  - b. Change the Total Votes for Mayor Candidate **Tim R. Irwin 415 to 432** on the Highland Primary Election 2013 printout to include the votes from the Provisional Ballots and timely absentees.
  - c. Change the Total Votes for Mayor Candidate **Larry M. Mendenhall from 543 to 564** on the Highland Primary Election 2013 printout to include the votes from the Provisional Ballots and timely absentees.
  - d. Change the Total Votes for Mayor Candidate **Tim Alders from 207 to 213** on the Highland Primary Election 2013 printout to include the votes from the Provisional Ballots and timely absentees.
  - e. Change the Total Votes for City Council Candidate **F. Chad Copier from 282 to 288** on the Highland Primary Election 2013 printout to include the votes from the Provisional Ballots and timely absentees.
  - f. Change the Total Votes for City Council Candidate **Scott LeRoy Smith from 684 to 701** on the Highland Primary Election 2013 printout to include the votes from the Provisional Ballots and timely absentees.
  - g. Change the Total Votes for City Council Candidate **Dennis LeBaron from 569 to 596** on the Highland Primary Election 2013 printout to include the votes from the Provisional Ballots and timely absentees.
  - h. Change the Total Votes for City Council Candidate **Ed Dennis from 699 to 722** on the Highland Primary Election 2013 printout to include the votes from the Provisional Ballots and timely absentees.
  - i. Change the Total Votes for City Council Candidate **Rod Mann from 755 to 799** on the Highland Primary Election 2013 printout to include the votes from the Provisional Ballots and timely absentees.
  - j. Change the Total Votes for City Council Candidate **Ryan Barker from 119 to 124** on the

Highland Primary Election 2013 printout to include the votes from the Provisional Ballots and timely absentees.

2. Declare Mayor Candidates, Mark S. Thompson and Larry M. Mendenhall proceed to the Highland City General Election to be held Tuesday, November 5, 2013.
3. Declare Council Candidates, Scott LeRoy Smith, Dennis LeBaron, Ed Dennis, and Rod Mann proceed to the Highland City General Election to be held Tuesday, November 5, 2013.
