Note:

The Division will not dictate to health care facilities or employers providing health care whether and how an unlicensed individual -- including any employee or volunteer family caregiver -- may or may not perform a listed task on behalf of the health care facility, <u>personal care provider</u> or employer.

An unlicensed individual who performs a task in accordance with this list will not be subject to sanctions by the Division as described under Utah Code Title 58 (Nurse Practice Act, Physician Assistant Act, etc.). The Division has jurisdiction over unlicensed practice outside of the parameters of this list. But the Division does not have jurisdiction over health care facilities (e.g. general acute hospitals, specialty hospitals, home health agencies, hospices, nursing care facilities, assisted living facilities, birthing centers, ambulatory surgical facilities, small health care facilities, personal care providers/facilities, health care facilities owned or operated by HMOs, or end stage renal disease facilities). Accordingly, all decisions to allow, or not allow, the performance of a listed task by an unlicensed individual belong solely to the health care facility or employer.
