Minutes- The Minutes of March 3, 2021 were emailed to the Council members previous to the meeting.

Bills- Larry read the bills. Trent made a motion to accept the bills as read, Larry seconded that motion. All in favor.

Annexation Ordinance 2-317- Chris Nielsen submitted a petition and application for Annexation multiple months ago. He has since had to go through a quiet title process to obtain a small parcel of land to the east of the Paradise Country Estates Subdivision. The annexation will clean up the property lines on the east side of the subdivision. The County has reviewed the Annexation petition. Trent made a motion to accept the Annexation Ordinance, Larry seconded that motion, all in favor.

Public Comment- None at this time.

Unfinished Business- Mat Weaver attended the meeting to assist the Council members with getting their new email account using outlook on their phones.

Mayor Little got updated bids for the Fire Department work. Mayor Little was not able to get the bleachers discussed at the last Council meeting before he was outbid on the website.

The Council discussed moving the green waste to the new park instead of having it in the middle of town. The large dumpster for Earth Day cleanup will be at the Town Square from April 12 to April 30.

Mayor Little reported that he did not submit an application for RAPZ funds for this year.

Mayor Little reached out to Garrett and Company concerning the planning of the splash pad and would like to start that process with them.

- **Roads-Trent Passey-** Trent reported that Morgan Paving will be here to patch potholes and slurry seal end of April beginning of May.

- **Fire/Grants/Budget- Jason Winn-** Jason reported that there have already been a few grass fires the Fire Department has responded to. He suspects that if we don't get much rain soon then it could be a busy season. Cache County Open burn starts on April 30 and lasts 30 days. Residents burning still need to obtain a burn permit so that dispatch knows.
