BASIC ELIGIBILITY

The Utah State Charter School Board (SCSB) certifies that a valid charter is in place for Providence Hall.

The SCSB certifies that Providence Hall does not have any serious, outstanding, or unresolved concerns.

The SCSB finds insufficient data to assess Providence Hall's progress towards fulfilling the goals specified in its original charter agreement that was created about 14 years ago; therefore, the SCSB recommends that Providence Hall update its charter goals. Other than this, the SCSB does not have any known concerns with Providence Hall meeting the terms of their charter agreement.

The SCSB certifies that there are no outstanding deficiencies based on criteria outlined in R277-553.

ACADEMIC PERFORMANCE

The SCSB uses the Utah School Report Card to assess a school's academic performance. The Utah School Report Card measures academic performance across multiple indicators. One of such indicators is academic achievement which shows the percentage of students who demonstrated mastery of grade-level standards in each subject. Providence Hall's achievement performance is summarized below.
