

Resolution 2021-01

Cleveland Town Council Support for Economic Development and Road Improvements to Jurassic National Monument (Cleveland-Lloyd Dinosaur Quarry)

1. Whereas, economic development is essential to financial stability in all communities, including Cleveland Town, and
2. Whereas, Emery County has an opportunity to receive federal grant monies of approximately \$5,000,000 for improvements of the road ending at Jurassic National Monument, and
3. Whereas, Emery County would only be required to match approximately seven percent of these funds, and
4. Whereas, Cleveland Town would have no financial obligations for this project, and
5. Whereas, many Cleveland citizens would benefit from an improved road to Jurassic National Monument, and
6. Whereas, many Cleveland businesses would benefit from increased visitation to Jurassic National Monument and/or the construction of said road improvements.

Therefore, be it:

7. Resolved, Cleveland Town publicly supports policies, programs, and procedures to stimulate economic development in Emery County and Cleveland Town, and
8. Resolved, Cleveland Town publicly supports Emery County pursuing the federal grant monies for road improvements ending at Jurassic National Monument, and
9. Resolved, Cleveland Town strongly urges Emery County to implement a policy for the lowest bid of a local contractors to be either accepted or for local contractor to be given

an opportunity to match the lowest bid if said local contractor's bid be within ten percent of the lowest bid when the lowest bid is from an nonlocal contractor, and

10. Resolved, this newly-implemented bid policy be in place and in effect prior to advertisement of bids for said road improvements, and

11. Resolved, for minimal traffic through residential areas and maximum traffic past existing businesses, signage for Jurassic National Monument should be placed near the South intersection of State Road 10 (SR-10) and State Road 155 (SR-155) -- directing traffic East on SR-155 ("Main Street"), then North on SR-155 ("Center Street"), then East on "300 North Street," then East on County Road 211, and continuing signage as needed outside the jurisdiction of Cleveland Town. Signage may also be added near the North intersection of SR-10 and SR-155 which will likewise direct traffic onto SR-155 and County Road 211.
