RESOLUTION NO. 21-15

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF TAYLORSVILLE ACKNOWLEDGING
RECEIPT OF A TENTATIVE BUDGET AND TENTATIVELY ADOPTING THE
TENTATIVE BUDGET PURSUANT TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF UTAH
CODE ANN. § 10-6-111 FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2021
AND ENDING JUNE 30, 2022**

WHEREAS, the Taylorsville City Council ("Council") met in regular session on May 5, 2021, to consider, among other things, acknowledging receipt of a tentative budget and tentatively adopting the tentative budget pursuant to the requirements of UTAH CODE ANN. § 10-6-111 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2021 and ending June 30, 2022; and

WHEREAS, UTAH CODE ANN. § 10-6-111 requires the City's Budget Officer to submit to the governing body a tentative budget; and

WHEREAS, the Budget Officer hereby submits to the governing body a tentative budget that meets the requirements of state law, attached hereto as Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, UTAH CODE ANN. § 10-6-111(3) requires that each tentative budget "shall be reviewed, considered, and tentatively adopted by the governing body" at a regular meeting and may be amended or revised as provided in the Uniform Fiscal Procedures Act for Utah Cities; and

WHEREAS, UTAH CODE ANN. § 10-6-113 requires that the Council establish a time and place of a public hearing to consider the adoption of the tentative budget and that notice of the public hearing be published at least seven (7) days prior to the public hearing; and

WHEREAS, the public hearing to consider the adoption of the tentative budget shall be held at the date, time, and location established in the City of Taylorsville Notice of Public Hearings, attached hereto as Exhibit "B"; and

WHEREAS, the Council desires to acknowledge receipt of and to adopt the tentative budget to the extent required by UTAH CODE ANN. § 10-6-111.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Taylorsville City Council that the tentative budget presented to the Council is hereby tentatively adopted to the extent required by UTAH CODE ANN. § 10-6-111.

This resolution, assigned Resolution No. 20-15, shall take effect immediately upon passage and acceptance as provided herein.

Public hearings will be held on **Wednesday, May 19, 2021 at 6:30 p.m.**, in the council chambers of Taylorsville City Hall at 2600 W Taylorsville Blvd in Taylorsville, Utah to receive public comment concerning the tentative budget for the City of Taylorsville for the 2021-2022 fiscal year and potentially for amendments to the 2020-2021 fiscal year. Interested persons are invited to appear at the public hearing and be heard. **Alternatively**, they may submit written comment to publiccomment@taylorsvilleut.gov no later than 6:00 p.m. on May 19th. A copy of the proposed budget can be found at taylorsvilleut.gov or with the city recorder at Taylorsville City Hall during regular business hours. Following the public hearing, the tentative budget for 2021-2022 may be amended, as appropriate, to reflect the public comment and other issues determined by the City Council. In accordance with the Americans with Disabilities Act, the City of Taylorsville will make reasonable accommodations to participate in the hearing.
