DISCUSSION ITEMS:

S.B. 23 DISCUSSION

Ms. Dennis provided the Board a brief overview of the new provisions for applicants applying for licensure via Endorsement. S.B. 23 will affect licensure through Endorsement for all professions. The purpose for this modification is portability and mobility for professionals across the country.

58-1-302. License by endorsement.

The division shall issue a license without examination to a person who has been licensed in a state, district, or territory of the United States if: (a) after being licensed outside of this state, the person has at least one year of experience in the state, district, or territory of the United States where the license was issued; (b)

the person's license is in good standing in the state, district, or territory of the United States where the license was issued; and (c) the division determines that the license issued by the state, district, or territory of the United States encompasses a similar scope of practice as the license sought in this state.

REQUIRED ANNUAL OPEN AND PUBLIC MEETINGS ACT TRAINING

OT COMPACT STATUS UPDATE

The compact status has been completed and will be discussed in the next legislative session. States that are part of the compact system will grant licensee's the privilege to work in another participating state with their home state license. For example, if a licensee has a compact license from Utah, they may practice as an OT in another compact state with their Utah license.


