### Academic Achievement

#### End of Level Testing

- RISE, ASPIRE PLUS, Acadience were all given this year, but will not count for/against us. The state has not given us comparable scores yet. Shawn will give you updates as the year progresses. (see attached)

### Community Relations

#### South Weber City

- Democratic party had their caucus at the school. They are always easy to host. We got a mention in the paper about hosting it.

#### Parent Communications

- We have the HighMark App and teachers use Remind Me app to communicate with parents.
- We are updating our website each month with Standard Based Learning; we will have a back to school night educating parents about it. Shawn has plans for getting the information to the parents and will share with you at a future Board meeting.

### Enrollment

- Attached is the lottery enrollment for next year – we have great numbers this next year!
- **Increasing Marketing**
  - ValPack advertising within 10 miles.
  - Facebook advertising has been really good. We used ages 21-55 within a ten-mile radius of the school. It follows those people and has done as well as word of mouth for the two months.
  - We gave 3 schools, Mt. View, Good Foundation and LLC a video to show and some school swag to distribute for us.
  - We advertised at HAFB for Easter parade. We have had responses already from that.
  - Krystal updates Facebook, Instagram and Twitter twice a week.

### Other

#### Faculty/Staff

- We have 3 jr high teachers who are moving on:  
Erin Denos (CTE) leaving for an IT position in DSD, Scov (math) is moving back to Michigan to be with his family, and Teanna Anderson-Hancock (history) is going to stay home with a baby.
- In elementary, we have 4 teachers leaving:  
Torey Thomson (3<sup>rd</sup> grade) is going to have a baby and will stay home with it; Tanner Pace (6<sup>th</sup>) will go to Northridge to teach; two 4<sup>th</sup> grade teachers are being released.
- Bonuses were given at Christmas; portfolio bonus \$1000 at end of school was given to teachers.



- We stay current with districts' pay with benefits and wages.
- We moved aides to 12-month contract with 3 PTO days which should help with retention.

#### **Counseling**

- Transitions to high school and 7<sup>th</sup> grade: 9<sup>th</sup> graders were able to register at our school with counselors from Northridge. We made sure 6<sup>th</sup> graders had time to understand jr high systems.
- She led groups in social, anxiety, behavior, etc.
- She is careful with changing schedules in jr high (especially 9<sup>th</sup>) to fulfill high school requirements.

**PTSO:** Angie Jensen is staying on as President, with Camille LaRose as Assistant.

- They will be using committees to take care of events. They are excited to get back to having events.
