MINUTES

REVIEW CURRENT AMENDMENTS AND RECOMMENDED CHANGES FOR 2021 IPC

The review of the current amendments for the 2021 IPC and recommended changes was tabled until the June meeting.

START THE REVIEW OF THE 2021 INTERNATIONAL SWIMMING POOL AND SPA CODE

The committee started the review of the 2021 ISPSC. It was pointed out the commercial pools are governed by the Department of Health and that the ISPSC is only for residential pools. The Committee reviewed each chapter and the following motions were made.

A motion was made by Don Simons to accept the changes in chapter 1. The motion was seconded by Nelson Hooton and passed unanimously.

A motion was made by Linda Ebert to accept the definitions in Chapter 2. The motion was second-

ed by Don Simons and passed unanimously.

A motion was made by Linda Ebert to accept the current amendment for the definition of private residential swimming pool. The motion was seconded by Nelson Hooton and passed unanimously.

The review of Section 311 was tabled until the June meeting. The recommendation for Chapter 3 was also tabled.

A motion was made by Don Simons to make a recommendation to accept the changes in Chapter 4. The motion was seconded by Nathan Lunstad and passed unanimously.

A motion was made by Don Simons to make a recommendation to accept the changes in Chapter 5. The motion was seconded by Nelson Hooton and passed unanimously.

A motion was made by Don Simons to make a recommendation to accept the changes in Chapter 6. The motion was seconded by Linda Ebert and passed unanimously.


A motion was made by Linda Ebert to accept the changes in Chapter 11. The motion was seconded by Nelson Hooton and passed unanimously.

At the next meeting the Committee will make their recommendation for Chapter 3 and the current amendment for Section 320.1. They will also start the review of the plumbing portion of the 2021 IRC.

The meeting adjourned at 11:37.
