BACKGROUND AND FINDINGS: <p>The City Council is granted the authority, by Utah State Code, to adopt ordinances that are “necessary and proper to provide for the safety and preserve the health, and promote the prosperity, improve the morals, peace and good order, comfort, and convenience of the City and its inhabitants, and for the protection of property in the City.” Due to the dry environment that exists on the hillside, it is necessary to prohibit certain types of fireworks that pose a threat to residences in the area.</p> <p>This Resolution reaffirms the City’s commitment to the safety of residents by prohibiting the discharge of aerial and fireworks within 100’ of areas identified on the map.</p> <p>As conditions on the hillside and in native areas throughout the City have worsened due to higher-than-normal temperatures and drought conditions, staff is recommending that additional restrictions be put in place to further restrict the use of both ground and aerial fireworks in the City. In addition to an outright ban on fireworks in all orange areas in the associated map, staff has created a yellow designation where aerial fireworks are still prohibited, but the use of ground fireworks may be appropriate. The newly created yellow areas and the prohibitions associated, were created due to the potential for fire with their proximity to dry native areas.</p>	
PREVIOUS LEGISLATIVE ACTION: <p>Cedar Hills adopted Ordinance No. 04-14-2021C, the proposed ordinance would further modify those restrictions for the 2021 firework season.</p>
