- **Theme 2: PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT.** Teachers and Paraprofessionals will meet personal performance goals through scheduled professional development, individualized plans, and mentoring programs.
- **Theme 3: ATTENDANCE.** Parents and families will follow the Attendance Policy and ensure students are to school daily, measured to 95% attendance rate.

- Both 3rd and 4th grade classes have not taken RISE summative assessments before.
 - Endurance to the length of the test was an observable concern.
 - ELA results were within five percent of expected results, but mathematics were much lower than predicted.
 - Writing is manually scored and results are not back yet.
 - Percent to cut scores has improved from year to year. This year it is evident with some students really excelling (for example, a 6th grade student that assessed at highly proficient in Math), while other students struggled more than they have before.
 - One goal is to continue increasing our percent to cut scores – meaning reaching 100% of the cut score; in addition, to increasing the number of students to proficiency. This focus helps students who already excel to continue excelling and to bring more students up to grade level

Other Notable Progress/Items for Awareness

- 2021-22 School Year
 - Staff
 - We are still hiring for paraprofessionals, two bus drivers, and one teacher
 - Summer 2021 – Has begun!
 - Focused on 200 students
 - Hours – M – Th, 8:00 – 2:30 PM for Charter & ELC M-F, 8:00 – 4:30 PM
 - For charter siblings of ELC students staying past 2:30 there will be an additional class
 - Charter will begin June 21st
 - Full transportation (pick up / delivery)
 - All students will be in the building
 - Breakfast, snack, and lunch served daily (students staying until 4:30 will have an additional snack)
- Lottery (Need to run the Lottery)
 - We have 63 students waiting for the lottery in Kindergarten
 - We have open spots in all other grades
 - We are full in 6th grade
- Each school year we teach fifth and sixth grades the maturation class in the spring; however, with COVID this school year, we were not able to have this event. We are schedule to teach that again this year. We have two nurses that come to the school and teach the boy and girls separately.
- As an organization, we do not charge any type of fee to our students, other then asking the family to replace a lost library book if needed. **(Vote)**

Other Notable Progress/Items for Awareness

- **Early Learning Plan (Vote)**

- By June 2022, Guadalupe Charter School will increase the percentage of second grade students who are scoring at or above benchmark on Acadience Reading composite by 5% from BOY to EOY by providing evidence-based interventions, professional learning and job embedded coaching with both second grade teachers, which includes classroom observations and lesson planning to increase the percentage of students who are able to accurately read with fluency. These students will also participate in 20 to 60 minutes of Lexia per week.
- By June 2022, Guadalupe Charter School will decrease the percentage of third grade students who are scoring below benchmark at the beginning of the year and then dropping to well below benchmark by the end of the year by 5% from BOY to EOY by providing evidence-based interventions, small group work and individual tutoring, which includes intervention observations, and rearranging as needed to decrease the number of students not making progress.
- The professional learning goal is to have all teachers from Kindergarten through third grade participate and implement the LETRS training as scheduled throughout the next two school years.
