The Town Council of Snowville Town held its regular monthly meeting at the Snowville Town Hall on **Wednesday 9th June 2021.**

Council Present

Mayor Heyder called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. He welcomed the council and all others present. Rod McGary led us in the pledge of allegiance and Tammie Morgan offered the opening prayer.

John Levenduski made a motion to accept the agenda. Keith Thompson 2^{nd} . All council members present voted yes.

Scott O'Hare made a motion to accept the minutes from the previous. John Levenduski 2nd. All council members present voted yes.

Deputy Averett

May 2021 Deputy Averette stated that there weren't very many calls for the month of May. Weapons Offense: 1- Individuals shooting towards livestock on Locomotive Road, Fled into Idaho before deputies arrived. Disorderly: 1- Upset truck driver at the gas station, left the area

without any incident, deputies were not needed. VIN Inspection:-1 Parking Problem: 1- Driver parked in the wrong spot at the station. Deputies arrived and the driver moved without incident. Total Calls for Service: 4. Deputy Averette stated that Element 11 was going to happen in September out West. County Fair is expected to be big this year, in August. Scott O'Hare stated that during the weekends that the traffic going north out of town has been busy and there are a lot of speeders. Scott also mentioned that they are working on fixing the speed limit signs that are outside of town. Deputy stated that they will have more deputies on duty so they will be able to respond in about 15 minutes. They are getting better staffed. Mayor replied that RockyMountain Power came out and they have approved the stoplight. North and South will run Red and East and West will run Amber. Mayor also stated that the people that don't live here don't see the stop signs. Mayor also stated that we are hoping to be done with the stop sign by August 2021. Mayor stated that today he had a big white van that was parked up by the school just seating there. When Mayor pulled around the man in the van knew that Mayor was watching him and hurried and left. Mayor tried to get his license plate number but couldn't. Deputy stated that if you see anything suspicious to call it in. Everyone Thanked Deputy Averette and the whole team for their efforts in keeping us safe.

Eric Dustler

Eric was excused. Mayor stated that on Monday Eric came out with Rocky Mountain Power to do a radius study for the light. They have to do another study so they are looking at a place for the stoplight to go. The project should be done in August 2021. Scott O'Hare asked why we can't have a 4-way stop? Mayor replied that because of Mollies Cafe`you can't see every will. Mayor stated that maybe in the future it will be done. Mayor also stated that he was getting a bigger stop sign with more lights. Mayor stated that we are waiting on the paperwork on the water study grant that will loop the water up around by Oman's to the Cemetery and down by Morgans. The corner is done and Mayor will take the cones down.

Garbage

Econo Waste's last day will be June 28th. The new vendor will start on July 8th garbage will be every Thursday he will pick it up between 9-2, there will be new rates, most people will only have one can. Econo Waste was going to charge us double for each can and only come out twice a week. Econo Waste wasn't very nice when he and Mayor talked. Jason Lower from IDWY is the new vendor he will come out on June 21st to meet with the Mayor and go around to the outside of city limits to talk to people about garbage pickup. We are going to charge a dollar more to put in a fund so when cans get broken so we can replace them. Mayor stated that many people will probably bring their cand back so we can spread them around.

Water

We had a public hearing about the connection prices. The lawyer said that we could charge an impact fee of \$2800.00 for a new service. The new connection prices are ¾ inch will be \$6,500.00, 1 inch \$7,500.00 2 inch \$8,500.00.

Scott O'Hare made the motion for the new water connections. Rod McGary 2nd. All the council members present voted Yes.

Mayor stated that we need to have no outside watering between the hours of 10 AM to 6 PM. He would like this to go out in the water bills for July, he also doesn't want any watering on Sunday. Mayor stated we have had temporary water restrictions in the past so everyone should be used to it. Mayor stated that we will have the water on in the park for the 4th of July so we will not have any fires on the 4th.

Rod McGary made the motion for no outside watering between the hours of 10 AM to 6 PM. and no watering on Sunday. Keith Thompson 2nd. All the council members present voted Yes.

Cemetery

Mayor stated that the Cemetery looked great for Memorial Day. He told the council if they see Scott Page tell him Thank You for a great job done. Mayor stated that since he has been Mayor they have replaced the well on the Cemetery three times, that if they start watering early they will have all the Elk and Deer in there breaking the white fence. In the past they have put an electric fence around it they have kept the cattle out but not the Elk and Deer.

Budget for 2021-2022

Tammie Morgan prepared the budget for 2021-2022. We had a Public Hearing before the town council to accept it.

Keith Thompson made the motion to accept the Budget for 2021-2022. John Levenduski 2nd. All council members present voted Yes.

Junk Yards

We have several in city limits. Mayor stated that everyone knows who those are without mention them. The new ordinances will have to be put in place first. Two people will be trained to write out citations and then go to court. The two people don't have to be on the council they will get paid for their time when we get everything place. They will have to be bold about writing citations. When the lawyer gets finished with the new ordinances then they will have to be adopted.

Dog Impound

Still working with Tremonton. We are making headway. It takes a lot of time.

Meeting with the Lawyer

Mayor and Keith meet with the lawyer and gave him all of the new ordinances that the council has been working on for a while now. The lawyer will look at them and make the changes that the council had made. The lawyer had a lot of questions about the water. Phase 1 and Phase 2. Tammie stated that AJ should know about the maps and she will ask him about them. Mayor stated that he has been looking for a map of the phases, but has not found it yet. Allan told Mayor that it was at the town hall. Mike Morgan stated that he might have one at his house, he said that he would look for it also.

Elections

We had two council member seats open and the Mayor's seat. LuAnn Johnson put in for Mayor and Garet Wirick and John Levenduski for the council seats. So we don't have to have an election.

4th of July

Scott O'Hare and Rod McGary are in charge of the 4th of July this year they are having an old-time carnival theme. They have planned a dunking machine, cotton candy, shaved ice, popcorn, they are having games for the kids like kickball, ring toss, pie-eating contest, water balloons. Robin Morgan will be in charge of the parade., she has asked for \$200.00 in prize money. Stacey will get it from the bank. Scott has ordered the meat from Lower's in Richmond Utah like years in the past. They are have pulled pork and beef sandwiches with salads and baked beans. Everyone is to bring a dessert to share. Scott received his credit card and the budget for the 4th of July is \$6,000. Scott will ask the Ranch House and Mollies if they would like to make the salads or the baked beans. If not he will order the stuff for Kent's. Scott has asked David Deakin to play some music with Brent Stokes and Dennis Polusen's band. The parade will start at 4:00 with the softball game after. Dinner at 6:00. Then music and fireworks. Mayor stated that he wanted a flag in the park. Stacey will order a solar light for the pole. Rocky Mountain Power donated \$500.00 for the 4th of July to the town.

Old and New Business

Bowery lights are working all the electrical work will be finished before the 4th of July. new LED lights in the bathrooms and kitchen, new circuit breakers. We have new electrical lines coming out of the ceiling. Keith stated that everything looks great. Gwen Johnson was the electrician that was awarded the bid. There is a rumor that the Black Pine Mine is not going to be as big as anticipated. Lagoon tickets will be available for the council and their families from June 13th through the 18th at a discount. Mayor has been asked if the Firetruck can go to the school next year for a water fight with the kids. Mayor was making sure everyone knew. Mayor stated that he is still using with the county to fix the potholes they are short-handed and as soon as they find someone to run the plant they will be out to fix the potholes in town. Mayor stated that Jed and Camie Pugsley are in the process of buying the Archibald property across from the Flying J. They are wanting to put in a truck parking with about 45 to 55 parking spots for trucks to park. They also are going to have bathrooms and showers for drivers to use. The parking lot will be secured with 24-hour surveillance, with a chain-linked fence all the way around it. Mayor stated that the project will be in phases, the first phase will be the parking lot, then the mechanic shop, then horse stalls for overnight travelers with horses that would like to have their animals strict their legs. Then a country store will be the last phase. Mayor asked the council if it was ok to give the Pugsley's a letter from the town saying it was ok with the town on with the Pusgley's were doing and that we would give them a business license. Tammie typed up a letter and Mayor signed it and gave it to Jed. Scott O'Hare stated that he was going to finish the dog kennel in the fire station if anyone wanted to help they were welcomed. Mayor stated that the ice machine in the fire station was working.

Acceptance of the Expenses Keith Thompson made a motion to accept the expenses with some exceptions. Lower Food, ScottO'Hare, Plan-It-Rental. Scott O'Hare 2nd. All council members voted yes.

Scott O'Hare made a motion to Adjourn. Keith Thompson 2nd All council members voted yes.
