Background:

Malouf Sleep has planned a celebration for their employees for the Pioneer Holiday. They have contracted with a professional fireworks company, provided proof of insurance and have obtained a permit from the Hyrum City Fire Marshal. They have also indicated that they will take extra safety measures of plowing the field that the fireworks will be launched over.

As originally approved, the Resolution 20-17 would not allow them to have the fireworks show. The amendment will allow them to move forward with the celebration, with safe guards in place to protect the surrounding area.

Amendment of RESOLUTION 21-17

A RESOLUTION REGULATING THE USE OF FIREWORKS WITHIN NIBLEY CITY

WHEREAS, dry summertime conditions increase fire hazards and necessitate special fire hazard mitigation measures; and

WHEREAS, Utah Code Annotated, Sections 15A-5-202.5 and 53-7-225 provide that municipalities may regulate and prevent the discharge of fireworks in certain areas with hazardous environmental conditions; and

WHEREAS, the Nibley City Council finds that it is in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of Nibley City to prohibit the use of fireworks in areas that are more prone to dangerous and deadly wildfires; and

WHEREAS, the State of Utah, Cache County, and Nibley City are experiencing drought conditions and dry brush and vegetation is prevalent and an poses an extreme fire danger.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE NIBLEY CIY COUNCIL THAT:

1. The use of aerial fireworks is prohibited in all Nibley City municipal boundaries until further notice.
2. The use of all fireworks east of SR 165/Main Street in Nibley is prohibited until further notice.
3. The Nibley City Heritage Days fireworks presentation is exempt from this Resolution.
4. **Professionally licensed and insured shows west of SR 165/Main Street in Nibley are exempt from this Resolution.**
5. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.
