

**Minutes of the North Logan City
Redevelopment Agency Meeting
Held on June 2, 2021
At the North Logan City Library, North Logan, Utah**

Brad Crookston made a motion to adjourn the City Council meeting and convene to the meeting of the North Logan Redevelopment Agency. Bruce Lee seconded the motion. A vote was called and the motion passed unanimously with Bruce Lee, Craig Humphreys and Brad Crookston voting in favor.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Damon Cann at 7:17 p.m.

Agency members present were: Bruce Lee, Craig Humphreys and Brad Crookston. (Roger Anderson arrived at 7:27 p.m. during the City Council meeting, and Buzzy Mullahkhel was excused.)

Others present were: Ulysses Black, Sara Monson, Korey Kinder (D.R. Horton), Lisa Hudson, Lydia Embry, Spencer Burt, Scott Bennett, Alan Luce and Marie Henschman.

Adoption of Agenda

Craig Humphreys made a motion to adopt the agenda as presented. Bruce Lee seconded the motion. A vote was called and the motion passed unanimously with Bruce Lee, Craig Humphreys and Brad Crookston voting in favor.

New Business

6:45 Public Hearing to receive public input on: 1) a proposed revision to the FY2021 RDA Budget, and 2) a proposed FY2022 RDA Budget. Following the public hearing, approval of resolutions may be considered to adopt proposed changes to the FY2021 RDA Budget and to adopt the FY2022 RDA Budget.

Alan Luce said he would not recommend approving the budget tonight, but just receiving input. He said he anticipates a budget revision to this during the year in relation to several items, including the Community Center, and what would be needed for some of the infrastructure improvements in that area. He explained further. He also discussed the installation of the traffic light at Wolfpack Way and 2500 North. He said these funds are very restrictive in what can be done with them, and explained further. He said the revisions to this would come back before the City Council.

Mayor Cann commented on this.

Mayor Cann opened the public hearing, and closed it at 7:19 p.m., as there were no public comments forthcoming.

Mayor Cann encouraged the council to meet with Alan on this over the next two weeks and review the items carefully. He also said that the traffic light going in on Wolfpack way is a critical improvement for us; and, does not think there will be another traffic improvement we will make in the course of the upcoming year that will do more to protect lives, as well as save dollars in terms of accidents, and commented further.

Bruce Lee made a motion to adjourn the RDA meeting and return to the regular portion of the City Council meeting. Brad Crookston seconded the motion. A vote was called and the motion passed unanimously with Bruce Lee, Craig Humphreys and Brad Crookston voting in favor.

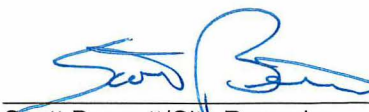
The meeting adjourned at 7:20 p.m.
