B. **PUBLIC HEARINGS:**

Ordinance: Sugar House Circulation & Streetscape Amenities Plan

Accept public comment and consider adopting an ordinance adopting the Circulation and Streetscape Amenities Plan for the Sugar House Business District. The plan proposes ways to improve transportation in the Sugar House Business District by making use of public transit, managing automobile parking, and increasing walkability and opportunities to bicycle on streets. Proposed ideas include closing the right turn lane south of the Monument Plaza, realigning Sugarmont Drive and Wilmington Avenue, increasing safety on Highland Drive between 2100 S and the I-80 overpass by changing to two traffic lanes with a center turn lane and adding bike lanes, dividing large blocks, adding bicycle lanes on parts of 2100 South, and connecting Parley’s Trail between the Fairmont Aquatic Center and Hidden Hollow. If adopted, the plan would be an addendum to the Sugar House Master Plan.
