Mayor Smolka,

The Salt Lake Valley Law Enforcement Service Area (SLVLESA) requests to be on the Emigration Canyon Township Council agenda for August 24, 2021. At the meeting, SLVLESA will be asking the Council to consider and take action on a proposed resolution approving a decision, if made by the SLVLESA Board of Trustees, to increase budgeted property tax revenues by 16.5% for calendar year 2022 resulting in a property tax levy that exceeds the certified tax rate.


