

CANVASS REPORT

2021 Primary Election

Provo, Utah

On August 10, 2021, Provo City held a Primary Election for the offices of Mayor, Council Member District 5, and Council Member City-Wide I. Provo City contracted with Utah County to conduct a vote-by-mail election.

Provo City had 45,441 active registered voters for the Mayor and Council Member City-Wide I positions. A total of 11,299 ballots were cast, for a voter turnout of 24.87%.

The number of registered voters in Council District 5 was 7,297 with a total of 1,242 ballots cast, for a voter turnout of 17.02%.

There were 183 mail ballots that were not accepted. Of the ballots that were not accepted, 40 ballots were returned unsigned, 21 signatures did not match the voter's record and could not be verified, 1 envelope was returned without a ballot, and 121 ballots were returned after the deadline.

Candidates nominated for office and whose names will appear on the ballot for November 2, 2021, are as follows:

Mayor:	Michelle Kaufusi Kenneth W. Dudley
Council City-Wide I:	Katrice MacKay Aaron Skabelund
Council District 5:	Rachel Whipple Coy Porter

Total votes for all candidates in each race can be found on the accompanying resolution. Vote totals by precinct will be provided by Utah County and made available on the voteprovo.com website following the official certification of the Canvass Report.

The November General Election will be held on Tuesday, November 2, 2021, and will be conducted by the Municipal Elections Officer in conjunction with Utah County, which will administer a vote-by-mail election.





9 WHEREAS, Municipal Primary Elections were held in Provo, Utah on Tuesday, August
10 10, 2021; and

12 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 20A-4-301 et seq. of the Utah Code (the "Code"), the
13 Provo City Municipal Council and Provo City Mayor constitute the Board of Municipal
14 Canvassers (the "Board") for Provo City and do hereby canvass the returns of the primary election;

17 WHEREAS, pursuant to statute, Amanda Ercanbrack, Provo City Recorder, is the election
18 officer (the "Election Officer") who has presented to the Board a report of the results of the election
19 as provided in the Code; and

21 WHEREAS, on August 24, 2021 the Board held a duly noticed public meeting to canvass
22 the results of the primary election, as provided in the Code.

33 4. The Board hereby certifies that 927 votes were cast for candidate Neil Mitchell.
34 5. The Board hereby certifies that 730 votes were cast for candidate Caleb Reeve.
35 6. The Board hereby certifies that 156 votes were cast for candidate M. David Gedo
36 Sanchez.
