Interview victims, witnesses and perpetrators concerning alleged criminal activity; prepare investigation reports; gather and preserve evidence.

Report to accident scenes to investigate potential collectivity, and to render first aid to injured persons and control traffic affected by the accident; investigate cause of accidents and prepare appropriate reports concerning the details thereof. Testify in court, or any other hearing; deliver/serve warrants, subpoenas and/or any other document requiring formal service thereof.

Investigate and suppress illicit acts involving narcotics, controlled substances and liquor.

Engage in interdiction of juvenile offenses and juvenile offenders; counsel juveniles to correct deviance/illegal/antisocial behavior.

Perform essential and administrative functions as part of effectuating arrests including taking fingerprints, gathering and preserving evidence.

Utilize and maintain specialty law enforcement equipment including, but not limited to radar/LIDAR, Taser, and nonlethal weapons.

Observes the general public to detect suspicious activities; investigates such observations including appropriate and necessary questioning of individuals, and gathering physical evidence.

Makes all efforts to locate stolen property to effectuate the return thereof to the owner.

Makes appropriate public relations appearances and interacts with the general public in educational purposes (e.g. the DARE program). Attends public gatherings, school classes and other functions as needed to educate the public and carry of the Wellington City Police Department and Wellington City.

Performs the duties of special functions officers and enforces Wellington City ordinances.

WORKING CONDITIONS:

A Police Officer works in a variety of working conditions. Those conditions will run the extreme from an office environment with little or no physical discomfort from noise, dust and temperature to the extremes of outdoor conditions with extreme hot and cold temperatures, blowing dust and dirt, and physical requirements of apprehending and controlling suspects.
