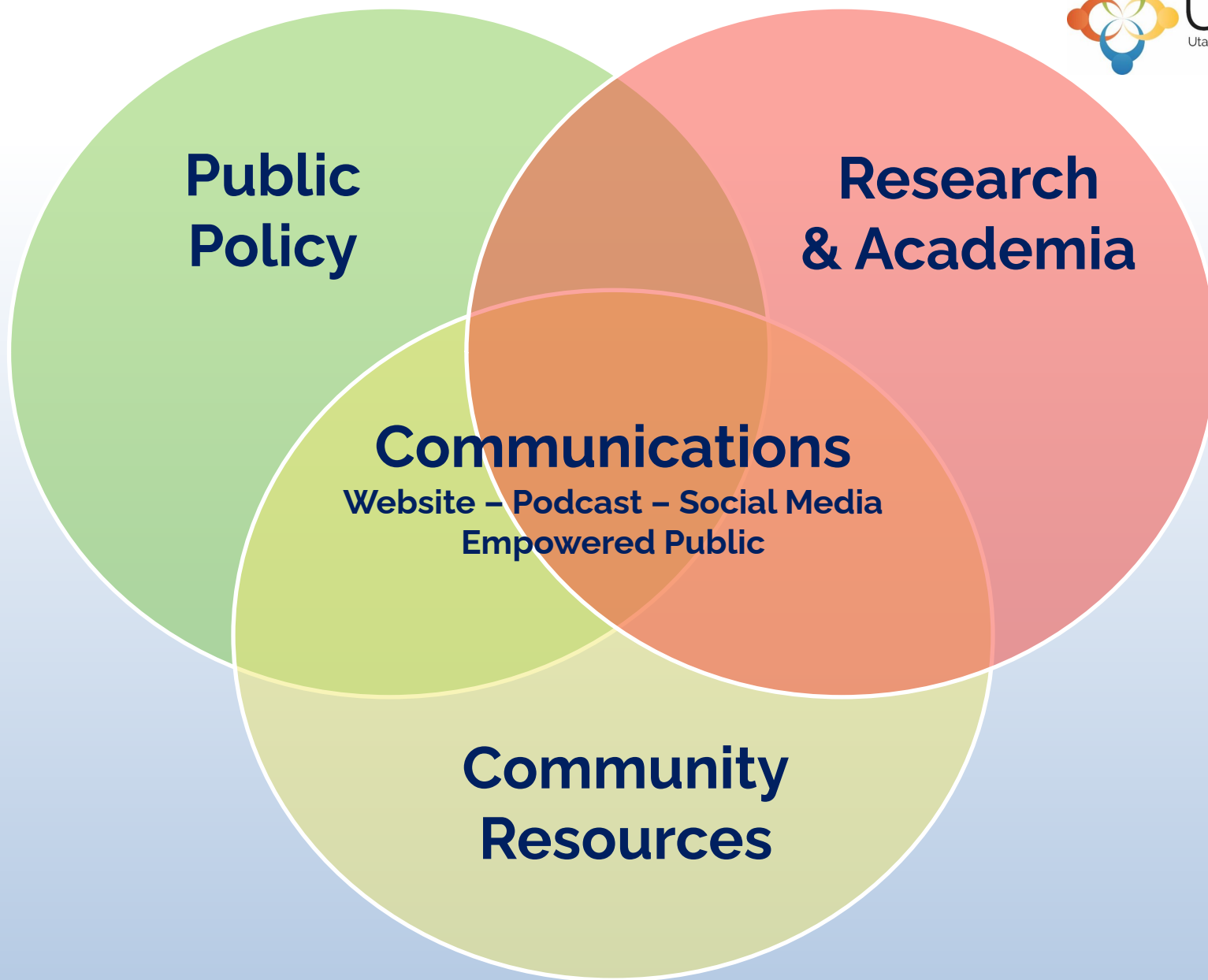

2010 – 2065 Population Pyramids For Davis County

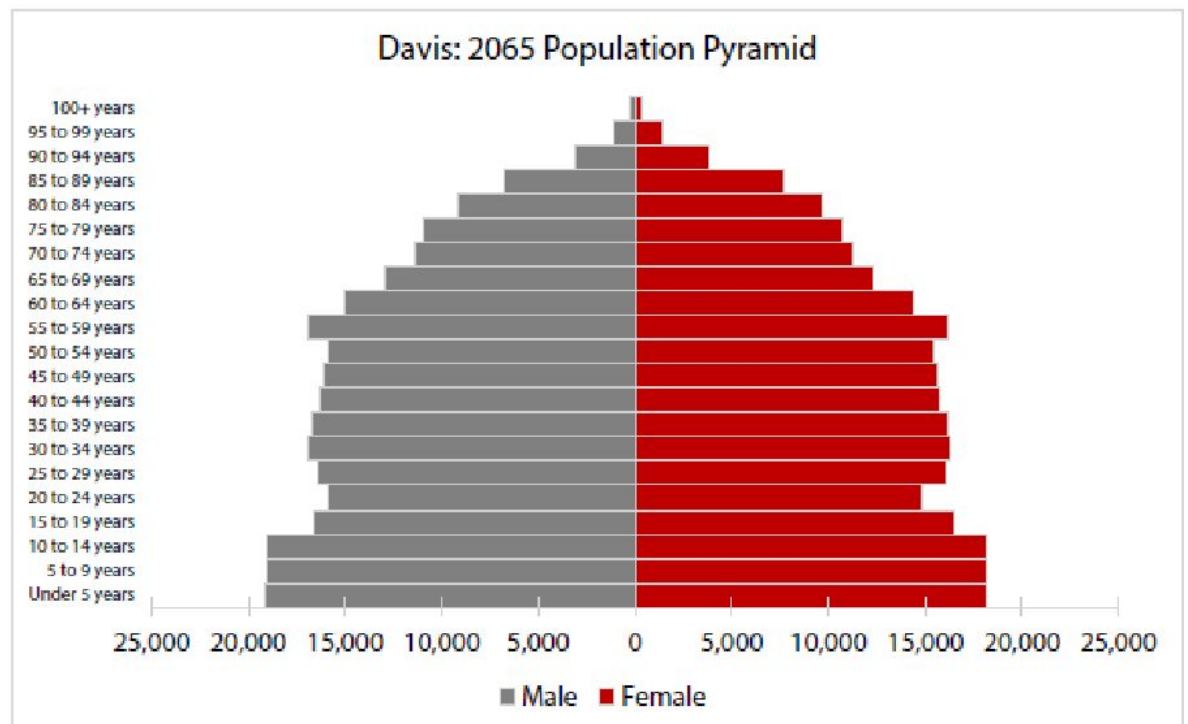
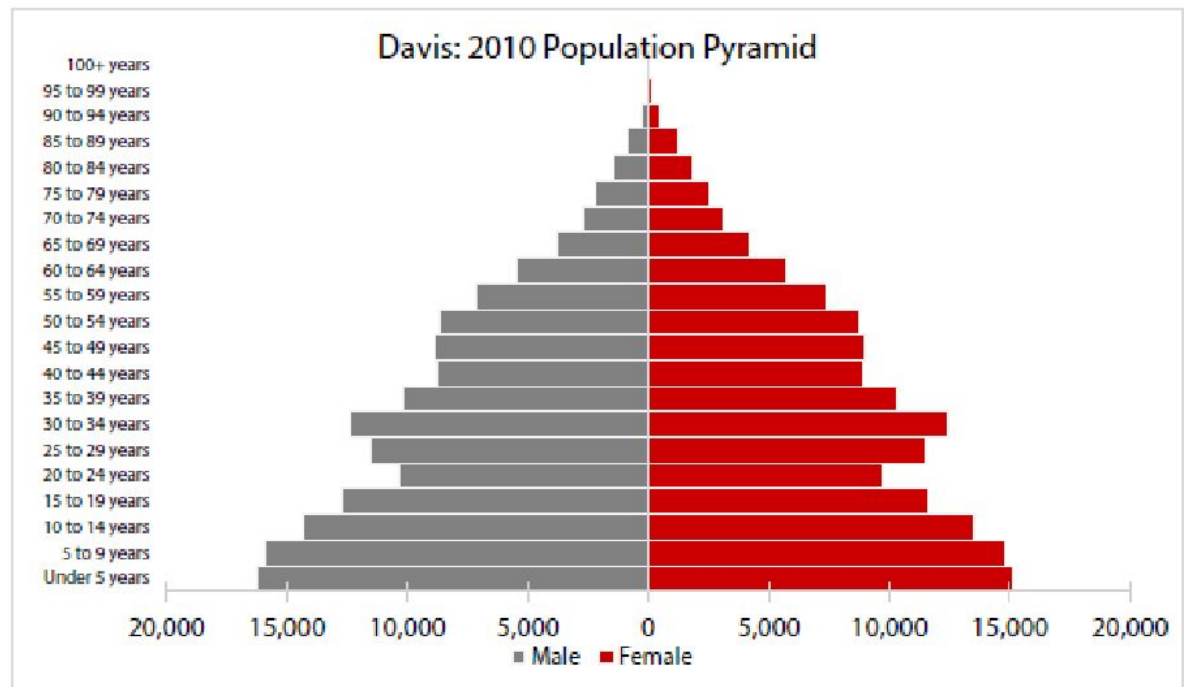
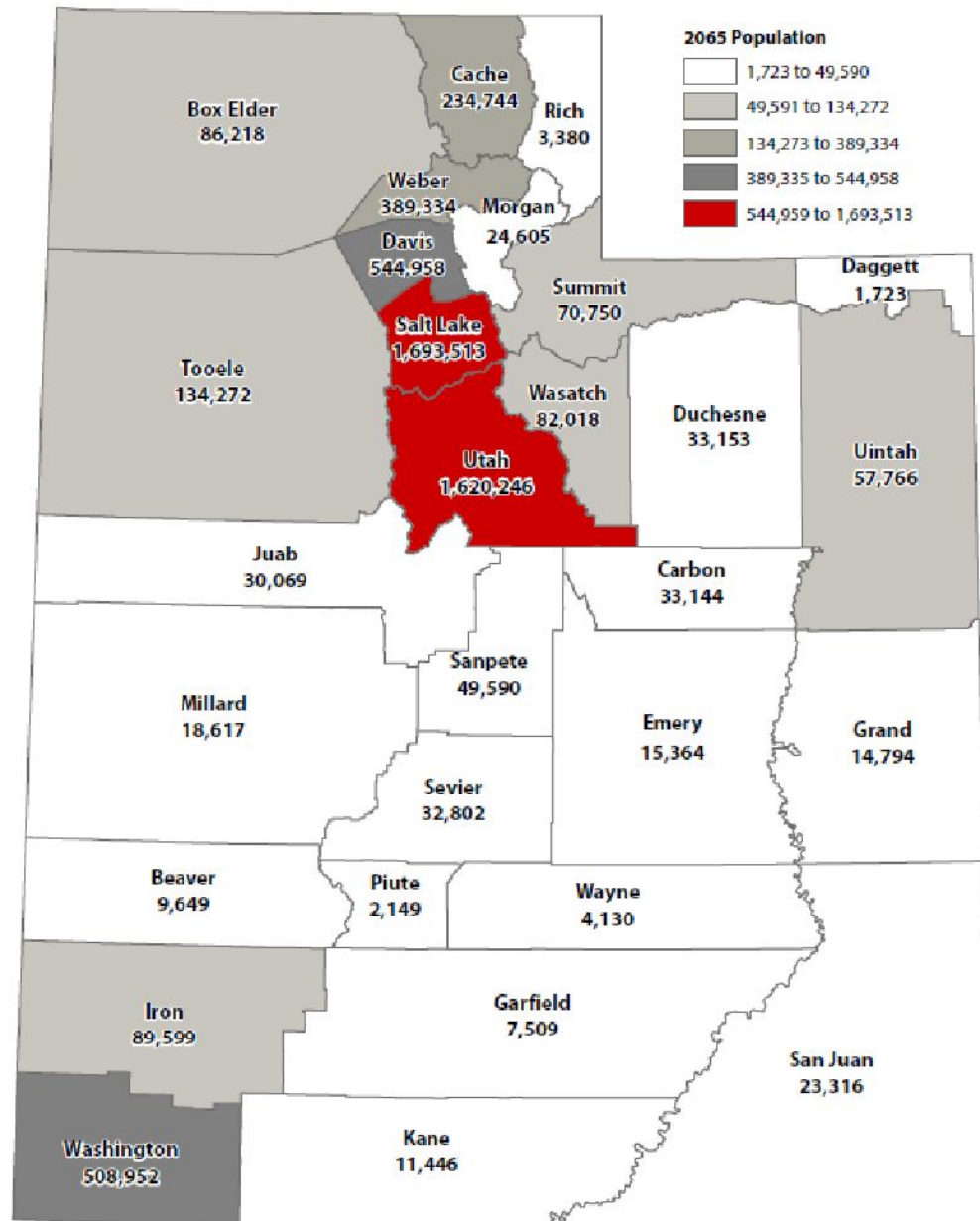
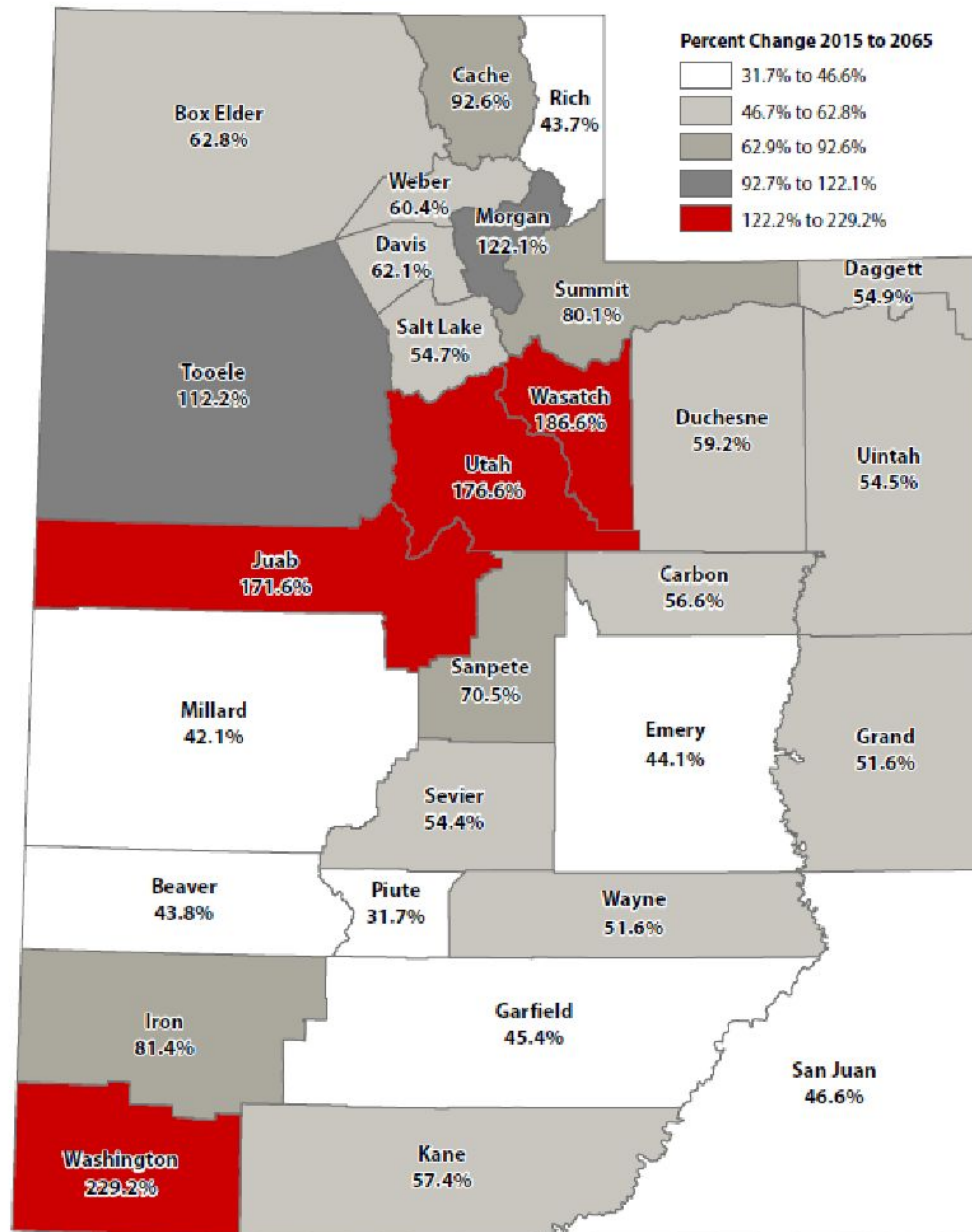
