Selecting Recommended Maps

- The process for selecting maps to be recommended to the Legislature is found at Utah Code Ann. § 20A-20-302(3).

Selecting Recommended Maps

- “To the extent possible, each map recommended by the commission shall be approved by at least five members of the commission.” Utah Code Ann. § 20A-20-302(3)(a).

Selecting Recommended Maps

- “If the commission is unable to obtain the approval of at least five members for all maps required under Subsection (2) for a particular map type, the commission shall, for that map type:
 - (i) if possible, recommend one map that is approved by at least five members of the commission; and . . .”

Selecting Recommended Maps

- “(ii) recommend two additional maps that are approved by a majority of commission members, as follows:”

Selecting Recommended Maps

“(A) one of the maps shall be approved by a majority that includes the commission member described in Subsection 20A-20-201(2)(f) [Baker]; and

(B) one of the maps shall be approved by a majority that includes the commission member described in Subsection 20A-20-201(2)(g) [Thorne].” Utah Code Ann. § 20A-20-302(3)(b).
