

4 AS THE BOARD OF CANVASSERS ACCEPTING THE ELECTION  
5 RETURNS AND DECLARING AND CERTIFYING THE RESULTS OF THE  
6 VOTE FOR GENERAL ELECTIONS HELD ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 2,  
7 2021, FOR THE OFFICES OF MAYOR, COUNCIL CITY-WIDE I, COUNCIL  
8 DISTRICT 2, AND COUNCIL DISTRICT 5, PROVO, UTAH.

11 WHEREAS, municipal general elections were held in Provo City on Tuesday, November  
12 2, 2021; and,

14 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 20A-4-301 et seq. of the Utah Code (the "Code"), the  
15 Municipal Council and Mayor constitute the Board of Municipal Canvassers (the "Board") for  
16 Provo City and do hereby canvass the returns of the general election; and,

18 WHEREAS, pursuant to statute, Amanda Ercanbrack, City Recorder, is the election  
19 officer (the "Election Officer") who has presented to the Board a report of the results of the  
20 election as provided in the Code; and,

22 WHEREAS, on November 16, 2021, the Board held a duly noticed public meeting to  
23 canvass the results of the election as provided in the Code.

25 NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Municipal Council and Mayor of Provo City,  
26 Utah, acting as the Board of Municipal Canvassers for Provo City, as follows:

30 1. The Board hereby certifies that 14,426 votes were cast in the mayor general election.  
31 2. The Board certifies that 10,752 votes were cast in the affirmative for candidate Michelle  
32 Kaufusi.  
33 3. The Board hereby certifies that 3,674 votes were cast in the affirmative for candidate  
34 Kenneth W. Dudley.  
35 4. The Board hereby certifies that candidate Michelle Kaufusi had the highest number of  
36 votes in the Mayor general election and declares her elected to the office of Mayor.

41 1. The Board hereby certifies that 14,369 votes were cast in the City-Wide I general  
42 election.  
43 2. The Board certifies that 6,165 votes were cast in the affirmative for candidate Aaron  
44 Skabelund.

46 Katrice MacKay.

- 47 4. The Board hereby certifies that 610 votes were cast for write-in candidate Tom Sitake; 93

50 votes in the City-Wide I general election and declares her elected as council member for

83 the State of Utah, all in conformance with state law.

## CANVASS REPORT

### 2021 General Election Provo, Utah

Provo City held a vote-by-mail General Election in conjunction with Utah County on November 2, 2021. A general election was held for the office of Mayor, Council City-Wide I, Council District 2, and Council District 5.

#### Mayor

There were 43,986 active registered voters for the Mayor position with 14,426 ballots cast for a voter turnout of 32.8%

#### Council City-Wide I

There were 43,986 active registered voters for the Council City-Wide I position with 14,369 ballots cast for a voter turnout of 32.7%

#### Council District 2

There were 5,072 registered voters for the Council District 2 position with 1,153 ballots cast for a voter turnout of 22.7%

#### Council District 5

There were 6,783 registered voters for the Council District 5 position with 1,593 ballots cast for a voter turnout of 23.5%

After review by the County, 14,597 ballots were counted, 319 were not counted. Of those 319 ballots, 54 were returned unsigned, 56 signatures did not match, 64 ballots returned from past election, 1 ballot was received without an envelope or affidavit, and 144 had invalid postmarks. There were 24 provisional ballots issued and 1 was not counted because they had already voted by absentee ballot.

Individual results of the election can be found in Resolution 2021-37. Candidates elected for office to serve terms of four years, beginning January 3, 2022, are as follows:

Mayor:	Michelle Kaufusi
Council City-Wide I:	Katrice MacKay
Council District 2:	George Handley
Council District 5:	Rachel Whipple


