

Toquerville City Nightly Rental Permit

This Nightly Rental Permit was granted to Sandra Feagin for a nightly rental located at 96 S Toquer Blvd; Tax ID # T-20-B. This application was approved by the Toquerville Planning Commission on February 19, 2020.

The conditions under which this Permit has been approved are as follows:

- 1. Each rental must occur within and under one roof of a dwelling unit and not in a structure that is temporary.
- 2. Applicant must provide enough off-street parking spaces for all guests and residents. There shall be no overnight on-street parking by guests or residents.
- 3. The maximum number of occupants per dwelling being used for nightly rental shall be the lesser of ten (10) (including the owner and his/her family), or that which is allowed by any Safety Code adopted by the City.
- 4. The owner of the dwelling where the nightly rental occurs must have his or her primary residence within the Municipal boundaries of the City.
- 5. Neither a natural person applicant nor a principal of a business entity applying for a nightly rental permit shall have an ownership interest in more than two (2) dwellings wherein nightly rentals occur within the City.
- 6. Any modification to the appearance and size of the dwelling in order to accommodate and facilitate a nightly rental should be in keeping with the residential character of the neighborhood within which the dwelling is located.
- 7. Applicant acknowledges the penalties for violation of this chapter as stated in section 10-17-3 of the Toquerville City Code.
- 8. Applicant acknowledges the record keeping requirements of this permit as listed in section 10-17-3 of the Toquerville City Code.

- 9. Applicant agrees to obtain all licenses required for the operation of this business including but not limited to; a business license, sales and use tax license, any other license required by any federal, state or local agency.
- 10. Applicant agrees to operate the facility in such a manner as to ensure that the premises where the nightly rental occurs meets all local, state and national health codes, regulations and requirements.
- 11. Applicant agrees that any sign placed or used at the business will comply with the regulations set forth in Chapter 22 of this Title.
- 12. This application will require an annual review by the Toquerville Planning Commission.
