Project Overview


Salt Lake City is continuing its efforts to improve roads and multi-modal transportation in Sugar House and the surrounding area. As part of this effort, the city is launching an environmental and concept design study to evaluate options and select a new design for 1300 East between 2100 South and 3300 South. This study is building upon previous transportation efforts in the area, including Local Link (link to website), and will incorporate existing recommendations for the road into the final design.

This study will identity gaps in the existing transportation network and challenges faced by those traveling between Sugar House Business District and Millcreek and will identity improvements for vehicle, pedestrian and bike mobility and safety.


