1. Approval of agenda:

Motion by Councilmember Holmgren to approve the June 23, 2021 agenda. Motion seconded by Councilmember Rohde. Vote: Arts Councilmember Ellis – aye, City Councilmember Holmgren – aye, City Councilmember Rohde – aye. Motion approved.

2. Approval of minutes—June 8, 2021

Motion by Arts Councilmember Ellis to approve the June 8, 2021 minutes. Motion seconded by Councilmember Holmgren. Vote: Arts Councilmember Ellis – aye, City Councilmember Holmgren – aye, City Councilmember Rohde – aye. Motion approved.

3. Business:

a. Discussion of Arts Festival

The Council discussed what vendors would be in attendance and which were still in the works. Manager LeFevre said we will provide picnic tables for food and crafts. The decorations from the National Yarn Bombing Day will still be up. The chalk I ordered is back ordered, but should arrive in time. If not, people usually bring their own and we do have some on hand. We split the adult category into competitive and amateur. For the competitive best in show they will receive \$150, the runner up will get \$100 and the amateur winner will get a canvas of their drawing. Councilmember Rohde said I could take a picture of that and then print it out if I have 45 minutes before we announce the winners. Manager LeFevre said we need to decide on three judges. We will put the kids drawing on two sheets of plywood (4x16 feet). The high school student body will oversee the children's portions and will have volunteers. We just have to figure that out and

create a list of supplies. Arts Councilmember Zollinger asked about a schedule of the day. Manager LeFevre said that is today's project and making sure we have everything tied down. We have a jukebox for the stage. We are still trying to fill spots for the entertainment, but we could do some sort of Karaoke or just play music. The concert will be at 7:30 p.m. Check in for the chalk art is at 7 a.m. and then the rest of it starts at noon.
